

Installation

- copy the directory „mingw“ (to d:\mingw)
- copy the directory „gcc-bsp“ to any directory

Link to the Compilers (gcc.exe or g++.exe)

- Change in the directory „gcc-bsp“
- Run then program „GccIDE.exe“

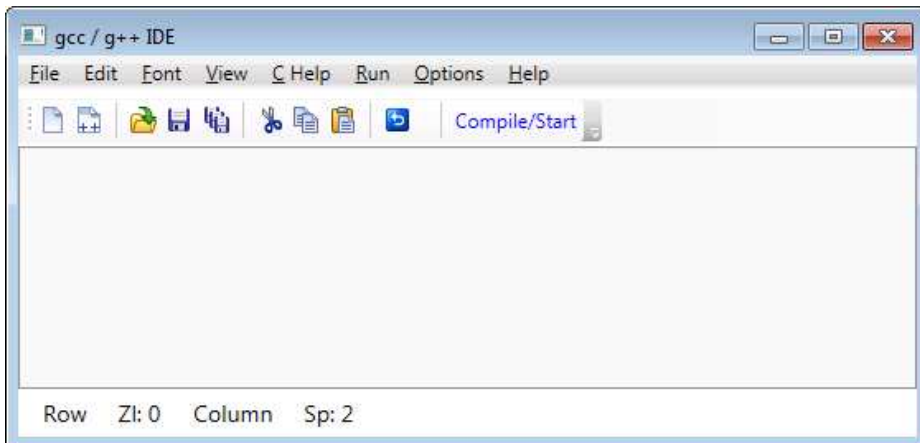


Abbildung 1 MainView

- Click the menu „Options“
- Item „Properties“
- Insert the file/path of the gcc-Compilers (button „select“)
 - gcc.exe
 - if you want to develop with C
 - g++.exe
 - if you want to develop with C++

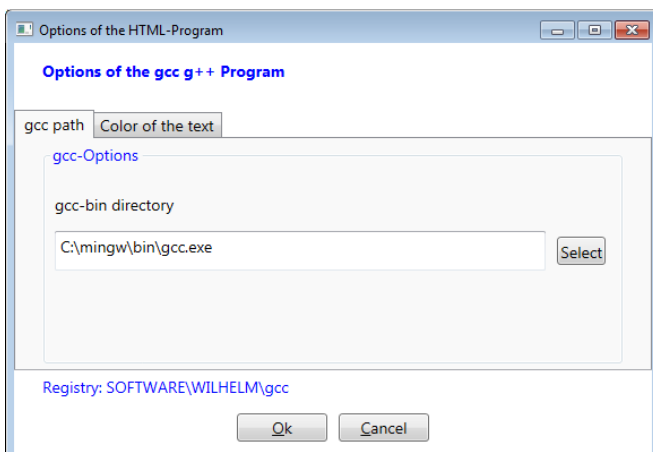


Abbildung 2 Dialog to select the compiler/linker

Wichtige Tastencode:

Strg+N	New C-File
Strg+M	New C++-File
Strg+O	Open a file
Strg+S	Save the file
F12	Save As
F5	Run the compiler and start the program
Strg+D	Run a dosshell
Strg+Shift+N	Run the Notepad
Strg+2	Run the Notepad with the active editor (à la backup)
Strg+Z	Undo
Strg+Y	Redo
Strg+F	Search
F3	Search again
Strg+A	Select all
Strg+C	copy
Strg+V	paste
Strg+X	cut

Hint:

- There is no wait à la Strg+F5 in Visual Studio.
- One must use the function „getch“
- getch wait fort he returnkey
